Everyday practice suggestions



Celebrate and embrace mistakes

The key idea in "My Way is the Best" is embracing the learning process and all its ups and downs. One way of helping our children succeed is through celebrating and embracing mistakes, as expressed by Professor Carol Dweck in "Mindset" where she talks about the kind of mindset that leads to growth. What this means in the process of language learning is for adults to avoid saying "I am bad at Chinese" or "I am bad at riding a bicycle" but just to acknowledge that "I don't know this word in Chinese" and then proceed to find out what it means. This is something we can model for our kids. And when our kids make mistakes, instead of making judgements such as "You' re always so careless", which assumes that being careless is "fixed", we can ask kids themselves to articulate a good way of solving the problem or of remembering a word. And don't shy away from telling stories of your own mistakes and failures. They are important for kids to understand the learning process.



Retelling stories

Retelling stories are a great way for kids to organize what they have just read and also to find their own interpretations. We can invite kids to retell stories verbally, through drawings, or through using their toys. They can also retell stories by telling it as an all-girl cast, all-boy cast, as an all-cowboy cast, etc.



Everyday practice suggestions



Practice reading aloud

Listen and practice using the Dim Sum Warriors Mobile Comic Reader App every day. Look for "My Way is the Best" and try "Voice Practice" about 5 to 10 phrases a day. Some kids enjoy challenging themselves and their friends and families to longer and longer sentences. When your child feels confident, record the whole book using your family's voices using the recording function in "Read". It's a lot of fun to have the whole book in your own voices.

After reading the book, go to our online Club HUB to play our recorded JAM sessions https://www.dimsum-warriors.com/club/. Look for the ones connected to "My Way is the Best". Have your kids draw, and better still, draw together with them. These sessions extend the learning from the books to new vocabulary and cool tools for reading, writing, and creating. Making connections between the text and self

After reading "My Way is the Best", chat with kids using the following prompts so that kids can make "text to self" connections. Pepper the conversation liberally and casually with the key words that are used in the text. You can tag the word as lists in this packet up on your wall as an easy reference.

Questions for parent and child to answer and discuss

Parents, please share your experiences as a child too:

- Shaomai is trying to learn to play with the Boing Boing Bat. Have you ever failed at doing something or have you ever been bad at doing something?
- How do you feel when you fail at something? What did that feel like?
 How is that compared to what Shaomai is feeling?
- Think of the times when you succeeded ed at something. How did you get to success?






