PISA GLOBAL COMPETENCE

PISA 国际素养

All Dim Sum Warriors stories are crafted to meet the **four target dimensions of global competence** that the Organisation for Economic Co-operation and Development (OECD) has incorporated into its Programme for International Student Assessment (PISA), the standard against which education systems worldwide are benchmarked. In our guide, we have indicated the specific dimensions that each of our stories addresses using the prefix **GCD** (for Global Competence Dimension):

GCD 1: the capacity to examine issues and situations of local, global and cultural significance (e.g. poverty, economic interdependence, migration, inequality, environmental risks, conflicts, cultural differences and stereotypes);

GCD 4: the capacity and disposition to take constructive action toward sustainable development and collective well-being.

GCD 4:

LEVEL OF DIFFICULTY

All our books may be read in any order, and independent of each other. The grammar is kept consistently simple and conversational. Certain books may contain instances where more sophisticated vocabulary is used. For the ease of teachers, we have indicated each book's level of difficulty in terms of vocabulary—**L1 (Grades 1-2)**, **L2 (Grades 3-4)** and **L3 (Grades 5-6)**.
